#1 - Mount with sky visibility

The Hazard Beacon kit has internal antennas for satellite navigation and cellular reception. Therefore the box needs to be mounted such that the sky is largely visible.

For best performance mount the box so that the top left corner is upward. The backrack of a truck is a good location to place the Beacon.

#2 - Wire to power and flasher power


Most Hazard Beacons will come with an 18 guage, 3 conductor wire (red/black/white). The red and black go to the vehicle's 12 VDC positive and ground. The white goes to the switched side of the flasher's positive line.

When the switch is turned off traffic systems are told the construction is finished.
