#1 - Charge your iPin™!

Lithium-Ion batteries are best stored at low charge levels so your iPin™ will generally come out of the box with less than a full charge.

You can charge the iPin™ by placing it in the sun with the switch off for a couple of days.

You can also charge it using a Micro USB 2.0 charger identical to the charger for most cellular phones. In the field, you can also charge your iPin™ with a cell phone car charger or a cell phone back-up battery.

#4 - In the field

When the iPin™ is switched on it determines its location from the GPS system and sends a message to traffic systems that says, 'there is a construction marker here'.

When the switch is turned off traffic systems are told the construction is finished.
